RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

The following qualifying rules apply in all cases:

 Contestant must be a child, stepchild, foster child, dependent or legal ward, or a linear/parental family member such as grandchild or great-grandchild of a sponsor who must be a MEMBER of the Boeing Leadership Association of Southern California (BLASC).

(Eligibility is continued in next column)

- Contestant's sponsor must be an active member as of June 1, 2022, with membership continuing through both the public presentation of the award and the funds disbursement.
- 3. Otherwise qualified candidates are not penalized for events beyond their control. Children or grandchildren of former, active members will be eligible under the following conditions, if on June 1, 2022, one of the following is true. During the immediate preceding year, the qualifying sponsoring chapter member: (1) became deceased or went on approved leave of absence, (2) retired under a company retirement plan, (3) transferred to another site or went on temporary layoff for less than two years. The above scenarios are allowable PROVIDED THAT the sponsoring member was a regular member with MORE than one year's continuous membership as of the date of such death, leave of absence, retirement, transfer, or layoff.
- Contestant must be a high school senior or academic equivalent who will graduate in 2023 or a college undergraduate student.

AWARDS

- Depending on the number of applicants, one or more awards will be made, based on available funds, and based on cumulative scores earned.
- 2. Awards are made as a lump sum payment.
- There are no restrictions upon the use of an award. The student may use the award to pay for tuition, books, and living or transportation expenses. Checks will be made payable directly to the student.

- A certificate of award will be presented to selected winners.
- 5. Award winners cannot be Boeing employees.

BASIS OF COMPETITION

Awards will be based on the highest cumulative score(s) from the following elements:

- Weighted grades achieved for academic subjects only (high school) or Cumulative GPA (college);
- b. A written essay covering a topic chosen by the applicant from a group of topics;
- An interview by a representative panel of the scholarship committee.

The scholarship committee will select a number of finalists from the original group of applicants based upon the application form and high school/college grades. Contestants will be notified by phone or e-mail of decisions regarding finalists

Anonymity is maintained throughout the competition.

Decisions made by the scholarship committee are final.
